Giunchigliani clinches two key endorsements

Fire Fighter and City Employee support follows fundraiser

How do you follow a successful fundraiser? For Chris Giunchigliani, candidate for Clark County Commission, the answer is by winning two key endorsements which were announced today.

“Chris Giunchigliani raised a robust \$74,000 at her event last night with over 100 people attending and hosted by Mayor Oscar Goodman,” wrote Jon Ralston the following day, February 23rd, commenting on the fundraiser.

One week later Giunchigliani won the support of two key groups, the Clark County Fire Fighters and the Las Vegas City Employees’ Association. Ryan Beaman, Fire Fighter President, said, “Fire fighters are also citizens and we, too, want a strong economy, good schools, safe streets, affordable health care, and a clean environment. We believe Chris Giunchigliani is the woman who can best lead this county in the right direction.”
