Chris Giunchigliani makes it official: files for Clark County Commission

*Race highlights contrast in style and substance, pits political
insider vs community advocate*

LAS VEGAS—Chris Giunchigliani made it official today by filing for the Clark County Commission District E seat, giving up her safe Assembly seat to challenge an incumbent, calling it “an opportunity for change.”

Giunchigliani, escorted by a crowd of 45 supporters, drew contrasts between herself and her opponent in remarks just prior to filing for office. “This is not a campaign to attack my opponent,” Giunchigliani said. “Instead, it is a referendum on how we as citizens want our government to work. I believe it is time to reassess the meaning of representation. It is time to reassess our decision making. It is time for change.”

Giunchigliani emphasized that in 8 terms in the Nevada Legislature, she was known for taking firm stands when she believed she was right, even when in disagreement with the political establishment, “On fairness to injured workers, in opposition to abuse of government power, in support of education, and in balancing a fair share of the tax burden I’ve stood firm. I will stand firm as your County Commissioner,” Giunchigliani told the group.

The 51-year-old candidate cited a difference in approach. “Openness and person-to-person contact are the hallmarks of my service,” Giunchigliani said. “I return every phone call, answer every note, respond to every email and meet whenever asked. As an elected representative, I see a duty to be the advocate of those I represent. I listen, I learn and I fight for my district. As your next County Commissioner, you can count on that.”

In the aftermath of scandals and convictions of former commissioners, Giunchigliani said, “The path to rebuilding public confidence isn’t through proclamations and press releases but by joining the public and making their voices heard throughout government.”
